The church now contains furniture and fittings from other Wren churches, most notably the splendid choir screen that stood originally in the Church of all Hallows the Great, Thames Street, now demolished.

Our hopeful planning is that the evening will be held again in the lovely courtyard garden behind the Church. A substantial buffet supper with wine and soft drinks will be provided and you and your guests are sure to enjoy this special evening in our own City Church.
