Our Chairman, Mrs Elaine Davis, invites you and your guests to attend the Coleman Street Ward Club annual Harvest Thanksgiving Service and Buffet Supper, to be held promptly at 6.00PM on Tuesday, 10 October 2017 at St Margaret Lothbury. While there has been a church on the site since the twelfth century, the present church was completed in 1692 after the Fire of London to the design of Sir Christopher Wren, with the addition of Robert Hooke's tower in 1700. The church now contains furniture and fittings from other Wren churches, most notably the splendid choir screen that stood originally in the Church of all Hallows the Great, Thames Street, now demolished.

The service will be led by our Chaplain, The Reverend Prebendary Jeremy Crossley, Rector of St Margaret Lothbury. Those who attend will also have the pleasure of hearing the magnificent George Pike England organ, completed in 1801 and considered to be the finest organ in the City of London. Once played by Felix Mendelssohn, it will be played during the service by Richard Townend, himself an organist of international renown, especially for his long-standing annual programmes of recitals at St Margaret Lothbury.

The hearty buffet supper, to be served in the Parish Rooms after the service, will provide an excellent opportunity for members and guests to forge new friendships and to strengthen existing ones in an informal setting. As ever, our friends and neighbours from Broad Street Ward Club will join us for the Service and the Supper.

This will be a joyful occasion and one very worthy of your support. Those of every variety of belief are, of course, most welcome to attend. There is no charge for attending the service, but there will be an opportunity to make a donation in aid of the work of St Margaret Lothbury. The cost of attending the substantial buffet supper, at which wine and soft drinks will be served, is £25. Your guests will be very welcome.

While members are encouraged to pay by BACS, cheques, payable to Coleman Street Ward Club, certainly remain acceptable. Your payment should reach me by 4 October, if you wish to attend.
